THAT COUNCIL, ACTING UNDER SECTION 114 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 2020 (ACT):

- 1. RESOLVES THAT THE REQUIRED STATUTORY PROCEDURES BE COMMENCED PRIOR TO CONSIDER SELLING THE LAND BY PUBLIC AUCTION AT 306-308 MAROONDAH HIGHWAY, RINGWOOD, AS CONTAINED IN CERTIFICATE OF TITLE VOLUME 8303 FOLIO 146, BEING SHOWN AS LOTS 1 & 2 ON TITLE PLAN NO. TP 830376 (SUBJECT LAND)
- 2. DIRECTS THAT IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 114 OF THE ACT, COUNCIL:
 - i. PLACE A PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED SALE ON COUNCIL'S WEBSITE;
 - ii. IN ACCORDANCE WITH COUNCIL'S COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT PROCESS:
 - PROVIDE A COPY OF THE PUBLIC NOTICE TO ANY PERSONS DIRECTLY AFFECTED BY THE SALE OF THE SUBJECT LAND; AND
 - iii. OBTAIN A VALUATION OF THE SUBJECT LAND
- 3. RESOLVES THAT THE PUBLIC NOTICE TO BE GIVEN AS PART OF COUNCIL'S COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT PROCESS SHOULD STATE THAT COUNCIL PROPOSES TO SELL THE SUBJECT LAND BY PUBLIC AUCTION FOR NO LESS THAN THE MARKET VALUE PLUS GST AND THAT SUBMISSIONS IN RELATION TO THE PROPOSED SALE OF THE SUBJECT LAND BE ADDRESSED TO THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER, MAROONDAH CITY COUNCIL
- 4. AUTHORISES THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR ANY OFFICER WITH DELEGATED AUTHORITY TO UNDERTAKE THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES NECESSARY TO ENABLE COUNCIL TO CARRY OUT ITS FUNCTIONS UNDER THE ACT IN RELATION TO THIS MATTER
- 5. NOTES THAT ONCE ALL PUBLIC SUBMISSIONS HAVE BEEN CONSIDERED, A FURTHER REPORT WILL BE PRESENTED TO COUNCIL TO DECIDE WHETHER OR NOT TO PROCEED WITH THE PROPOSED SALE
