"For rate payers that fall outside the categories of Indigenous, LGBT and climate and immigration supporters, what value does the rates payment provide other than rubbish pick up services?"

Chief Financial Officer

"Council rates go far beyond waste collection, for which there is a service charge.

Rates go towards supporting over 120 services and facilities used by a range of people within or external to the Maroondah community - this includes parks and playgrounds, libraries, local roads and footpaths, community safety and sports facilities.

All whilst we maintain over \$2.2 billion in community assets, that all require extensive renewal expenditure to help ensure they stay intact and deliver on their purpose.

Whether someone uses the library, plays a sport, drives on a local road or visits a park - rates are integral in contributing to the liveability, safety and amenity of the whole community, and not one specific group."

"What is the education plan for Maroondah, given the strain on our local school. With many primary and secondary schools at or near capacity, our growing population exacerbates these issues. Issues such as overcrowding demonstrate that larger schools do not equate to better educational environments. These conditions hinder student wellbeing and academic success. Retaining and rezoning the Croydon South site for educational use could alleviate pressure on existing schools and address the rising demand for quality facilities.

Can you provide details on the Maroondah's Education Plan that address these challenges?"
