"Council can appreciate that these incidents and events can be emotive and impact individuals and families quite significantly, and have compassion in these circumstances, whilst we aim to undertake a consistent approach to all the claims that are received. Of course, any acceptance of a public liability claim will always depend upon whether the claimed loss or damage stems from legally negligent action or in-action by Council. Each case must be assessed on its merits, on a case-by-case basis. Whilst each resident's insurance company, where applicable, do handle claims processes differently from one-another in their dealings with Council. Claim settlements, including payment of insurance excess, may be considered in circumstances where clear legal liability can be established whilst appreciating the level of hardship the individuals or families have faced in these circumstances"
